	A penny = 1 cent, a nickel = 5 cents, a dime = 10 cents, a quarter = 25 cents and a dollar = 100 cents.	
1.	Joan opened her piggybank to find out how much money she had to spend on kitty stickers. In the bank, she found 1 quarter, 3 dimes, 1 nickel, and 3 pennies. How much money does Joan have for kitty stickers?	
2.	If Liam has 2 quarters and 3 nickels. After he spends 30 cents, how much money does he have?	
3.	If James has 5 dimes and 1 quarter. Isabella has 3 quarters and 1 nickel. How much more does Isabella has?	
4.	If John found a large number of coins while walking on the sidewalk to a softball game. On the sidewalk he found 3 quarters, 2 dimes and 1 nickel. How much money did John find?	
5.	If Martin has a total of 20 nickels and 5 dimes. How much money does he have?	
6.	Standing around in a store, Jason discovered numerous coins lying on the ground. After gathering all the coins, he counted 2 quarters, 2 dimes, 3 nickels, and 3 pennies. How much money did Jason collect off the floor?	
7.	John has \$17 to spend on baseball cards. Each card that he wants costs \$0.50. How many cards can he buy with his \$17?	
8.	Peter bought a turkey sandwich, and received his change in several coins. The cashier handed Peter 3 quarters, 3 dimes, 1 nickel, and 2 pennies. How much money did Peter get in change?	
9.	If Emily has 95 cents and Abby has 3 quarters and 1 dime. How much more money does Emily have?	
10.	If Alexander has 1 nickels and 2 dimes. Aiden has 1 quarter and 3 dimes. After Aiden gives Alexander 1 of his dimes, how much money does Alexander has?
