

The Niagara Falls

Niagara Falls is located at the border of Ontario, Canada, and New York, USA. The American Falls, Bridal Veil Falls, and Horseshoe Falls are the three separate waterfalls that make up Niagara Falls. Every second, more than 3,000 tons of water fall over Niagara Falls. Over 10,000 years ago, melting glaciers formed Niagara Falls. They joined the nation's first park, Niagara Falls State Park, in 1885. Niagara Falls pours onto Lake Ontario. About 1/5 of the world's freshwater supply is contained in Niagara Falls, composed entirely of fresh water.
